Project Information

One of the leading providers of further education in North London, Southgate College commissioned Caswell to undertake re-inspections of its premises following an earlier survey by another consultancy, as part of the asbestos register compliance requirements

The contract presented a number of challenges. Although the survey work was undertaken outside of term time, it did have to be carried out in a manner that caused minimum of disruption to students and staff who were on site. The buildings at the college site were of different ages and styles, meaning that the level and types of asbestos discovered varied from building to building and that each required an individual approach.

During the course of the project it became apparent that some additional debris had not been identified in the original survey due to access and limitations. The college and Caswells moved quickly to assess the work and incorporate it into the site programme with a minimum of disruption so that the overall completion was not significantly delayed.
